### WEEKLY MESSAGE

Our situation in Adams has eased to *HIGH CAUTION*. However, Covid-19 cases continue to be high in Berkshire County. Friday's Eagle (11/5) reported that the county's 7-day average increased to 41 new cases per day, up from 36/day for the previous week. The DPH lists Adams at **56 new cases** over the last 2 weeks (Slide 6). The good news is that only 10 new cases were reported in Adams between October 29 & November 4 (Slide 4). That deserves a "*Tip o' the Hat*" along with the hope that we can stay focused for a bit longer. The big news is the authorization of the Pediatric Pfizer Vaccine!

# CHILDREN'S VACCINE AVAILABLE!

The US Food & Drug Agency (FDA) issued an emergency use authorization (EUA) to immunize children ages 5-11 years with the Pfizer/BioNTech COVID-19 vaccine ("Comirnaty"). As with adults, 2 doses are given 3 weeks apart; the dosage is lower (% or 10 µg vs. 30 µg for adults). Berkshire County has received vaccine. Clinics are scheduled in most public elementary schools. Letters were sent to school principals with information for families, including the full school clinic schedule.

#### ADDITIONAL VACCINE INFORMATION:

- Elementary school clinics are planned, generally 1-3 hours after school. The Hoosac Valley Elementary School clinics are scheduled for Monday, November 15, and Monday, December 6. There may be others schedule in the county

- Please note the requirements regarding permission & adult accompaniment.
- Children turning 12 between their 2 doses may receive either dosage.
- CDC also recommends vaccination for children who previously had Covid-19. However, each family should consult their own pediatrician.





Cumulative Confirmed & Probable Deaths: 323

Symbols indicate change when compared to prior two-week period. For New Cases, Incidence per 100,000, and Total Tests: Higher (upward arrow) means the number in the current two-week period is higher than the prior period. Lower (downward arrow) means the number in the current two-week period is lower than prior two-week period. No change (equal sign) means the number in the current two-week period is the same as the prior period. For Percent Positivity: less than 0.10% difference in the percent positivity is considered No change (equal sign).





#### 11/4/21 data: 14-day case counts (Oct 17 – Oct 30, 2021)


