On the above date the Board of Selectmen held a meeting at Town Hall at 7:00 PM. Chairman Duval presided, present were Michael Ouellette, Arthur Harrington, Joseph Nowak, Richard Blanchard, Jonathan Butler, Town Administrator and Edmund St. John III, Town Counsel.

Chairman Duval called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM

## **MINUTES**

A motion made by Member Ouellette, seconded by Member Blanchard to approve and waive the reading of the minutes of July 10, 2013 – Unanimous motion passed

A motion made by Member Ouellette, seconded by Member Blanchard to approve and waive the reading of the minutes from July 17, 2013 – 4 Yeas, 1 Abstained (AH) motion passed.

## **CITIZENS CONFERENCE**

Resident Jeff Lefebvre asked the Board if the RFP went out on the campgrounds for the Greylock Glen. Jonathan Butler, Town Administrator replied that they had not gone out. The RFP will not go out till there is execution of the 99 year lease on the property which is expected to be in October. Jeff also asked about the bridge on Grove Street, this is a state project that is completely a DOT project; the Town has no role in it. The last communication from them is that there was a change order which is causing the delay. He also asked about the Solar Bylaw, Chairman Duval stated that they will be having a discussion in a workshop in the next few weeks. Jeff also commented that he was glad the Town received the money for the Middle School. On October 2<sup>nd</sup> the Town will be setting the Tax rate, Jeff asked if they had an idea of how much of an increase it will be. Chairman Duval replied that it hasn't been discussed yet.

Michael Piorot asked the Board if he could place a sign at the street light alerting drivers to expect delay for the Annual Fall Run on Sunday, September 29<sup>th</sup>. The Board unanimously approved the request.

Resident, Shaun Sutliff of 196 East Road presented to the Board a petition regarding the solar project on 217 East Road. There are over 300 signatures of residents and people from other communities that are opposed to this project. A copy of this petition is attached to these minutes.

David Babcock, from Berkshire Works wanted the Board and residents to know that he is available at the Visitors Center on Thursday mornings from 9:00 AM – 12:00 PM to assist with job searches.

## **NEW BUSINESS**

There was discussion by the Board regarding the Solarized Massachusetts Program. Jonathan Butler stated to the Board that ultimately if the Town were to decide to pursue the program which has the potential for residential solar on several of the homes in the community, the Town

would need to response by October 22; he feels this can be done. The more complicated piece is the local interest component the Town would have to demonstrate that there is significant interest in the community to participate and drive a successful program. Because of that piece he recommends that the Board meet in a workshop to discuss how to roll this out. Other pieces are more technical they are more grant writing ability. Member Ouellette is very in favor of moving forward and being involved in this program as were all Board Members. It was decided that the next Board Workshop meeting this item would be on the agenda.

## **SUBCOMMITTEE/LIAISON REPORTS**

Member Novak asked if there were any communications regarding the Park Street project. Mr. Butler replied that the Community Development Department is in communication with the Department of Housing on the state level. The state we are at currently is that an environmental impact study has to be completed for Park Street. This has to be done before Bid documents can be finalized and updated by Tighe & Bond.

## **ADMINISTRATORS REPORT**

1. The Town has received a \$600,000 award for replacement of a major portion of the roof at the Adams Memorial Building. The award came from the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Reserves Program. The Town had applied in early August, and is very encouraged to have received the state's support in the form of this grant award. Next steps will include getting a contract for the funds executed with the Commonwealth, and then getting under contract with an architect for the project.
2. The Board had been approached multiple times by a Member of the Parks Commission about the installation of hand-rails along the bleachers at Renfrew Park. After some investigation into the concern, the Town was able to come up with a solution. The Department of Public Works mechanics reviewed the structures and determined that they could handle the installation, and we are expecting to have them working on it by the end of the month. Installation itself should only take around a week.
3. Verbal updates on MJD Real Estate Howland Avenue Property and former Duteau Building on Commercial Street.

## **POLICE DEPARTMENT**

Chief Tarsa updated the Board on the issues from concerned residents of Crotteau Street. He met with residents to address the issues and he has spoken with Town Officials regarding complaints through their office that he was unaware of. He has also spoken to the owner of the property and he has agreed to cooperate and speak to the tenants to address the issues.

## **TOWN COUNSELOR'S REPORT**

The following work was performed since my last report:

- Attendance at Board of Health meeting to discuss school nurse's contract issues with public and staff of St. Stanislaus Kostka Elementary School. Discussions with counsel for Diocese regarding above issues.
- Continued communication with legal counsel for Bay State Elevator regarding inspection issues.
- Continued investigation of status of Gould Road as a public way.
- Preparation of responsive pleadings to legal complaint against the Town.

A motion made by Member Blanchard, seconded by Member Ouellette to approve the Facilities Request for NB21 to use the Visitors Center on the third Tuesday of each month – Unanimous motion passed.

## **GOOD OF THE ORDER**

Member Harrington wanted to commend the Department of Public Works for the nice job they have done on the sidewalks and around Town they are doing some nice repair work. He is impressed with the work that they do.





It is our hope to gain the support from the Town Administrator, Select Board and those whom we trust have the town's resident's best interest at hand to stop this project.
