

#### 10 Things to know about your new Medicare card

#### They are starting to be mailed April 2018

- 1. Mailing takes time: Your card may arrive at a different time than your friend's or neighbor's.
- 2. Destroy your old Medicare card: Your Adams COA can shred it for you
- 3. Guard your card
- 4. Your Medicare number is unique
- 5. Your new card is paper
- 6. **Keep your card with you:** Carry new card and show to your health care providers when you need care.
- 7. Your doctor knows it's coming
- 8. **You can find your number:** If you forget your new card, you, your doctor, or other health care provider may be able to look up your Medicare Number online.
- 9. **Keep your Medicare Advantage Card:** If you're in a Medicare Advantage Plan (like an HMO or PPO), your Medicare Advantage Plan ID card is your main card for Medicare—you should still keep it and use it whenever you need care. However, you also may be asked to show your new Medicare card, so you should carry this card too
- 10. **Help is available:** If you don't get your new Medicare card by April 2019, call 1-800-663-4227. TTY users can call 1-877-486-2048

## Circuit Breaker Senior Citizen Property Tax Relief

The Circuit Breaker is designed to give income eligible senior citizens a credit of up to \$1,080 on their property taxes.

You may qualify if You:

- Are age 65 or older by December 31, 2017
- Own or rent in Massachusetts as principal
- Residence

Your total income does not exceed:

Single filer: \$57,000
Married filing jointly: \$86,000
Head of household: \$72,000

Who is Ineligible?

- Those who receive federal or state rent subsidy
- Those who are a dependent of another tax payer
- Those whose property is assessed at a value of more than \$747,000

How Much is the Credit?

As of January 1, 2017—capped at \$1,080

This tax credit is applied to what is owed for income tax. If the credit is more than what is owed, a refund (interest free) will be issued.

Ask your Tax Preparer if you qualify!

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
