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The Adams COA Long-Distance **Medical Transportation Program** is in trouble and we need volunteers to keep it running!!!

- *This program is funded in part by a grant from Elder Services of Berkshire County, Inc. and the Executive Office of Elder Affairs. However, it depends on volunteer drivers to bring people to and from their appointments in Central and South Berkshire County, Western MA, Albany/Capital Region, Bennington VT, and occasional trips to Worcester and Boston. Volunteers determine how far they are willing to travel.
- In 2023, we provided 55 older residents of Adams, Cheshire, and Savoy with 250 rides to from medical offices outside of North Berkshire County in our 2017 Nissan Rogue (donated by Fallon Health in January 2018). In that same time frame, we were unable to meet the needs of at least 15 people for 37 rides due to an unavailable driver or the car already being reserved for another resident.
- We currently only have 2 drivers that are available regularly and 2 that are available occasionally.
- Responsibilities include: Pass a criminal background check and have a clean driving record; Drive seniors to and from medical appointments throughout the county, state, region in the COA car; Maintain record of trips (record sheet provided); Conduct simple pre and post trip car inspections


