

What is a pumpkin walk?

Pumpkin Walk is a FREE event sponsored by Mill City Productions, in collaboration with the Adams Council on Aging and the Adams Events Committee. The public is invited to stroll around an outdoor display of jack-o-lanterns and enjoy free cider and donuts!

When and where?

There are two nights to view the pumpkins: Saturday, Oct. 29 and Sunday, Oct. 30, from 5:30pm to 7:30pm outside at the Adams Visitor Center (dress warm!).

How much does it cost! No I need a ticket!

This is a FREE event for our Northern Berkshire community and no ticket is needed. All children must be accompanied by an adult, however, and we ask that you respect the pumpkins.

How can I get involved?

We need your jack-o-lanterns! The more pumpkins we have, the better the event will be. One word of warning, however: carved pumpkins don't last long so we need pumpkins that have been carved within a week of the event. Want to carve (or paint) but not deal with the mess? Come to our pumpkin carving session at the Adams Visitor Center on Friday, Oct. 28, 5:00pm-7:00pm (masks required). We'll provide the tools, cleanup, and snacks. Bring Your Own Pumpkin, but we will have a limited number of pumpkins available on a first-come, first-serve basis for those who don't have one!

When/where do I drop off my carved pumpkin?

You can drop off your pumpkin at the Adams Visitor Center on Friday, Oct. 28 from 5:00-7:00pm.
