The Town of Adams is soliciting quotations from qualified firms for the clean-up, removal and disposal of building materials assumed to be hazardous (asbestos, lead, etc.) in an existing one-story structure (former service station) located at 26 Commercial Street in Adams. The selected contractor shall perform general routine pickups and onsite Emergency Hazardous Materials Abatement, Cleanup, and/or Toxic Remediation Services as directed by the Town of Adams, Massachusetts. The contractor must adhere to all State and Federal prevailing wage laws and all other federal, state and local regulation. Contractor shall possess a current Massachusetts hazardous substances removal certification.
